Code	EPA Name	# Needed/Block (8 total + & COD-8)
COD-2A	Assessing and managing patients with complex <b>CHRONIC</b> conditions: <b>ASSESSMENT &amp; RX</b>	2
COD- 3A	Providing internal medicine <b>CONSULTATION</b> to other services: <b>PATIENT ASSESSMENT &amp; DECISION MAKING</b>	2
COD-3B	Providing internal medicine <b>CONSULTATION</b> to other services: <b>WRITTEN COMMUNICATION</b>	2
COD-10	Implementing <b>HEALTH PROMOTION STRATEGIES</b> in patients with or at risk for disease	2
COD-8	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient <b>SAFETY INCIDENT</b>	Always do when you can
COD-2B	Assessing and managing patients with complex chronic conditions: <b>COMMUNICATION</b>	Optional (0-1)
COD-6	<b>ASSESSING CAPACITY</b> for medical decision-making	Optional (0-1)
