<b>COD-4A</b>	Assessing <b>UNSTABLE PATIENTS</b> , providing targeted treatment and consulting as needed: <b>PATIENT CARE</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>COD-1</b>	Assessing, diagnosing & managing patients with complex or atypical <b>ACUTE</b> medical presentations	<b>2</b>
<b>COD-2A</b>	Assessing & managing patients with complex <b>CHRONIC</b> conditions – <b>ASSESSMENT &amp; RX</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>COD- 3A</b>	Providing internal medicine <b>CONSULTATION</b> to other services: <b>PATIENT ASSESSMENT &amp; DECISION MAKING</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>COD-5</b>	Performing the <b>PROCEDURES</b> of Internal Medicine	<b>Always do when you can</b>
<b>COD-8</b>	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient <b>SAFETY INCIDENT</b>	<b>Always do when you can</b>
COD-6	<b>ASSESSING CAPACITY</b> for medical decision making	Optional (0-1)
COD-7	<b>DISCUSSING SERIOUS OR COMPLEX AREAS OF CARE</b> with patients, families, and caregivers	Optional (0-1)
